**Motor Vehicle Policy**

1. Motor vehicles may be brought onto Bustins Island only with permission of the Board of Overseers (Board), as provided under Article XVI of the Bustins Island By-Laws and only on the basis of commercial need or to provide essential services to the community.
2. At the time such permission is sought to bring a vehicle onto the Island, the date of delivery and removal of the same must be fixed and agreed to by all parties.
3. Permission may be granted to keep a motor vehicle on the Island for a limited time period or until a specific job is completed.
4. The Board may require a Bond to be posted, with or without sureties, to cover the expense if the BIVC must remove or dispose of the vehicle. The Board may impose other conditions on such vehicle use, as they may deem appropriate.
5. At the time permission is sought, the purpose of which the vehicle is to be used must be documented, and the vehicle may be put to no other use without further permission of the Board.
6. Motor vehicles may not be loaned to or used by others except properly licensed employees of a contractor, to whom permission is granted.
7. Vehicles may not be used on Island ways until the Superintendent determines that the roads are in sufficient durable condition to permit such use.
8. The person to whom permission is granted must have a legal driver's license and must accept responsibility in writing for any damage caused by this use to the Island's road, culverts, or other property. That person is responsible either for the repair of such damage directly or for reimbursement to the BIVC for the cost of having any repairs done by the Board.
9. The vehicle must be removed from the Island as specified by the Board in writing if any of the foregoing conditions are not met, or if the Board determines that the use of the vehicle or its operation is the cause of any issue the Board considers to be undesirable for the safety or welfare of the Island.
