

Freight is defined as anything which is:

- not a personal item (clothing, food, medication, toiletry items, and bedding)
- too bulky to be carried by hand by a single passenger
- too heavy to be carried by hand by a single passenger
- identified by the captain as freight

The ferry has an extensive list of freight items, along with charges associated with those items. If there is an item of freight that is not on the list, the captain will find a similar item on the list and levy a similar charge. If a similar item cannot be located on the list, then the following freight rate schedule will be used:

- \$2 for items < 50 lbs
 - \$5 for items \geq 50 lbs up to 100 lbs
 - \$10 for items \geq 100 lbs
 - additional \$10 for each 100lbs of weight > 100 lbs
